Right now, the target dates are **July 11 & 12** to resume both **Saturday and Sunday** services. Although we will have guidelines in place by the time of reopening, it's understood that we may have to adjust as we go along if information about the virus and/or our community changes. Nonetheless, our goal is always to respectfully care for your spiritual needs as well as your physical well-being. If you aren't ready to come to Church or have an underlying condition that prevents you from returning, Good Shepherd will continue to post weekly services online.
